More about the Event:

The National Conference for Single Catholics (NCSC), which takes place in a different part of the country each year, will be held at St. John's Resort in Plymouth, MI, August 25th-27th.

The conference is organized by Anastasia Northrop, a longtime promoter of John Paul II's work and message. She has taken to heart the Church's call to a New Evangelization and ministers in particular to single Catholics of all ages. Her conferences have been welcomed in thirteen dioceses across the United States, with support from the local ordinaries and bishops of neighboring dioceses. The conference normally draws 400-500+ attendees from over 40 states, as well as internationally. Ms. Northrop was graciously invited by both the Archdiocese of Detroit and the Diocese of Lansing to hold the event in Michigan this year! She is excited to work with these dioceses and to be hosting the conference again in the Midwest.
